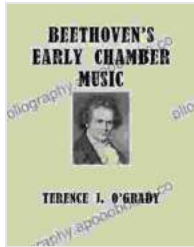

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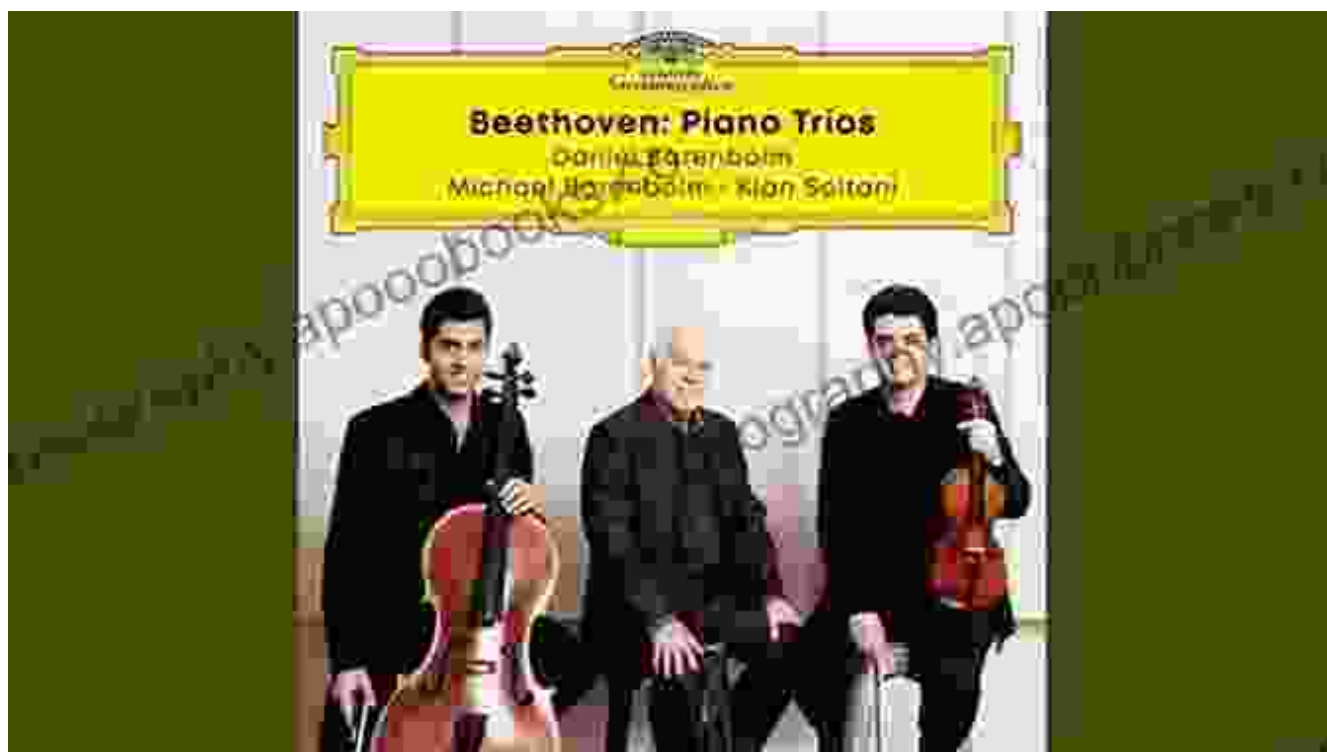

Piano Trios: A Trio of Delights

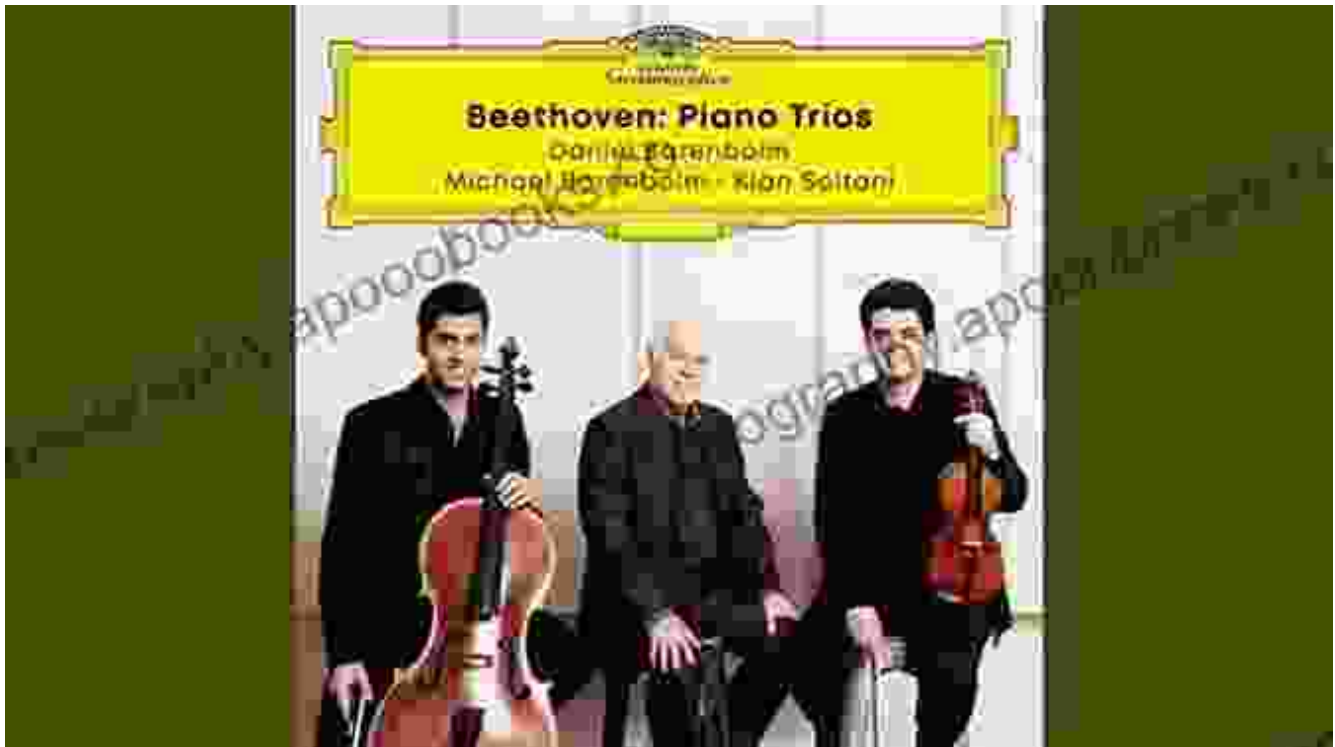
Trio in E-flat Major, Op. 1, No. 1

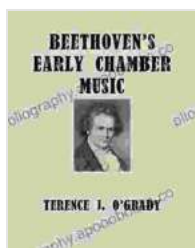

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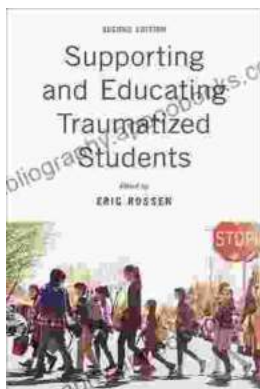
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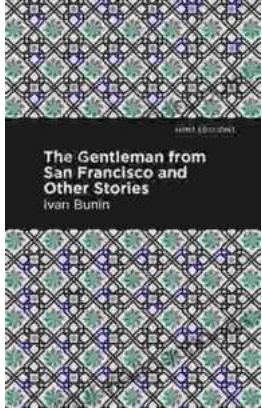
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
