




About the Author

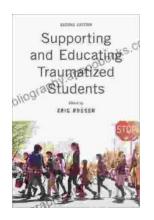

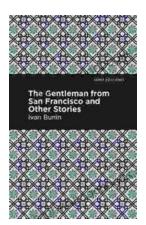
